Funk Engineering earns extension on Cleveland Clinic's on Ohio Third Frontier Project


Local firm continues work on prosthetic knee project

CLEVELAND, OHIO - OCTOBER 12, 2012

Funk Engineering, a full-service engineering consulting firm, has announced that it will continue working with the Cleveland Clinic on the Ohio Third Frontier Project.

The project, part of the Ohio Third Frontier Program's Rapid Rehabilitation and Return to Function for Amputee Soldiers (RRRFAS) grant, received an extension through the end of 2012. Originally, the project was extended through September 30. Now, the Cleveland Clinic was given until December 31 to continue the project.

As part of this extension, the Cleveland Clinic did not receive additional funding, but adjusted budgets to ensure the continued work of Funk Engineering on the project.



"We're very excited for the opportunity to stay on board for the duration of the project," added Justin Funk, president of Funk Engineering, "especially considering how close we are to the integrated robot test, which was one of the original goals for the project."

As part of this project, Cleveland State University graduate students have access to the hardware for the prosthetic knee and will continue research into different walking gaits and control algorithms.
